Student Conduct Process Adviser Rights and Responsibilities

I understand that the following rights and responsibilities apply to me as an adviser in the Lafayette College Student Conduct Process:

1. The right to refuse to serve as an adviser overall or to attend any particular conduct meeting or hearing.
2. The responsibility to interact only with the student being advised. Advisers may not interact with case administrators, members of the committee, or witnesses presented by other students or the College.
3. The right to be free from retaliation for my participation or lack of participation in the conduct process.
4. The right and responsibility to report any alleged retaliation to the Office of Public Safety.
5. The right to waive any of the above listed rights.
6. The right and responsibility to ask for additional clarification on the procedures at any point during the conduct process.
