## *Student Conduct Process Witness Rights and Responsibilities*

I understand that the following rights and responsibilities apply to me as a witness in the Lafayette College Student Conduct Process:

1. The right to elect not to attend a conduct meeting or hearing.
2. The right to decline to answer questions asked by a case administrator, the panel, the respondent, or the complainant.
3. The responsibility to be truthful in all statements made to the case administrator or panel. Intentionally providing false information may result in an allegation that I have violated the Conduct Code Integrity Policy which can be found in the Student Code of Conduct.
4. The responsibility to limit my statements to information that I know and which is related to the incident(s) in question.
5. The responsibility to not discuss the content of my statements with witnesses who have not yet presented to the case administrator or committee.
6. The right to be free from retaliation for my participation or lack of participation in the conduct process.
7. The right and responsibility to report instances of perceived retaliation to the Office of Public Safety.
8. The right to waive any of the above listed rights.
9. The right and responsibility to ask for additional clarification on the procedures at any point during the conduct process.
